PRAYER ALERT OCTOBER 2024 - JANUARY, 2025

Tuesday, October 1, 2024

Give praise to the Lord for the new month.

Its Nigeria's 64th Independence Day celebration. Plead God's mercy upon the nation. Ask the Lord to bless the leadership with wisdom and integrity and to bring about true freedom—both spiritual and physical—for its people. Declare that unity, justice and progress will be the order of the day in Nigeria again.

Wednesday, October 2, 2024

"And I will pour on the house of David, and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication..." (Zechariah 12:10).

Ask the Lord to pour out the Spirit as Promised and grant that our intercessions in the coming days will yield great testimonies and cumulatively bring the harvest to a close.

Commit the ongoing Urban Missions Research Project unto the Lord. Pray for the success of the project, and that outcome will be catalytic in proper engagement of the harvest in the cities.

Thursday, October 3, 2024

The Nigerian church is diverse, with various denominations, but unity in mission can enhance the work of the gospel. Pray for unity among churches

and ministries in Nigeria to work together for the advancement of the gospel. Ask that the spirit of competition be replaced with a desire for collaboration in fulfilling the Great Commission.

Friday, October 4, 2024

The Muslim world, with over a billion adherents, remains one of the most unreached mission fields globally. In many Islamic nations, Christians face severe persecution. Pray for the Muslim world, that God would reveal Himself to Muslims through dreams, visions, and the witness of believers. Ask that Christian workers be protected and empowered to share the gospel in love and without fear.

Saturday, October 5, 2024

Cross-cultural missionaries face unique challenges as they adapt to new languages, customs, and environments. Pray for grace, patience, and wisdom for missionaries serving in different cross-cultural contexts. Ask that they build meaningful relationships and communicate the gospel effectively despite cultural differences.

Sunday, October 6, 2024

Many new converts in Nigerian churches struggle with deep spiritual growth due to a lack of discipleship.

Pray for a renewed focus on discipleship in the Nigerian church. Ask that churches raise mature believers who are rooted in the Word and equipped to disciple others.

Monday, October 7, 2024

Sowers Ministries

Sowers Ministries is focused on mobilizing young people for missions across Nigeria. October is dedicated to a National Outreach that will reach an unreached people group in Osun State. Pray that young people will continue to be called to missions and that the October outreach will result in the establishment of a new church in Osun State and beyond. Pray for the success and impact of the outreach.

Tuesday, October 8, 2024

Give praise to the Lord for the progress being made in seeing Bibleless tribes have God's words in their language. The work is not yet done. Pray for ongoing Bible translation projects across Nigeria. Ask for God's blessing on translators and for His provision to complete these kingdom projects. Pray that as the Scriptures are translated, lives will be transformed by the Word of God.

Wednesday, October 9, 2024

Media remains a powerful tool for evangelism and discipleship, especially in hard-to-reach areas where missionaries cannot physically go. Pray for the effective use of radio, television, social media, and other platforms to spread the gospel. Ask that the messages shared would reach many, especially in restricted areas, and bring many to Christ.

Thursday, October 10, 2024

Pray for Christian healthcare workers in Nigeria, especially those serving in remote communities. Ask that they be strengthened in their work and that God would use them to bring healing—both physical and spiritual—to those they serve.

Friday, October 11, 2024

Core North of Nigeria is predominantly Islamic, and evangelism in this region is often met with hostility and persecution. Pray for courage and protection for gospel workers in this region. Ask God to soften the hearts of those who hear their message and for entire communities to come to Christ. Declare that the gospel spreads unhindered.

Saturday, October 12, 2024

Christians in certain parts of Nigeria, especially in the North still face persecution for their faith. Pray for persecuted believers, asking God to give them strength, courage, and peace. Pray for their safety and for God to intervene in their situations, turning the hearts of their persecutors toward Christ.

Sunday, October 13, 2024

The Evangelizers Team Ministry International

Mpu village and surrounding Okpanku community are still deeply involved in idol worship. However, the light of Christ is beginning to shine through our outreach efforts. Pray for revival in these communities. Ask that God's Spirit be poured out and for the few believers to grow in faith and become instruments of God's glory in their land. Pray also for missionaries working among the people, that they will be filled with wisdom and strength.

Monday, October 14, 2024

Nigeria's urban areas keep growing, and this is creating both challenges and opportunities for missions work. Pray for wisdom for missionaries and ministries working in urban settings, ask that they would effectively reach those in the cities. Ask for resources and partnerships needed to prosper in urban ministry to be available.

Tuesday, October 15, 2024

Many frontier mission fields in Nigeria are home to widows and orphans, often living in extreme poverty. Pray for ministries and missionaries who are providing for widows and orphans in their communities. Ask God to meet their physical and spiritual needs and to bring hope to the vulnerable.

Wednesday, October 16, 2024

A number of Christians in Nigeria face spiritual complacency and need revival. A spiritual awakening is crucial for advancing the Great Commission. Pray for a powerful move of the Holy Spirit across Nigeria, awakening believers to deeper faith and action in missions. Ask that churches and Christians be stirred with passion for evangelism and discipleship.

Thursday, October 17, 2024

The Nigerian diaspora is growing globally, offering opportunities for Nigerian Christians to be ambassadors for Christ in other nations. Pray for Nigerian believers living abroad to boldly witness to the people around them. Ask that they serve as a light to their communities, drawing others to Christ through their faith and actions.

Friday, October 18, 2024

Shafa'at in Arabic which means to "intercede", is an Islamic practice of pleading with God for the forgiveness of a believing sinner by a friend of Allah (Muslim saint). Pray that God will send gospel bearers that will reveal the true path to forgiveness to the Muslims. Pray that Jesus will be revealed to them as the only way to earn forgiveness.

Saturday, October 19, 2024

The 2024 Field Missionary Retreat, with the theme 'Jesus, the Model,' is exactly a month from today. This event aims to refresh and renew missionaries for continued service. Pray for the success of the 2024 Field Missionary Retreat. Ask that the Holy Spirit move powerfully during the retreat, bringing encouragement, spiritual renewal, and grace to the missionaries attending. Declare God's blessings upon the planning.

Sunday, October 20, 2024

Partnerships between missions agencies, churches, and local communities can significantly amplify the reach and impact of the gospel. Pray for effective partnerships and collaborations in missions work across Nigeria. Ask for unity, shared vision, and mutual support to drive missions initiatives forward.

Monday, October 21, 2024

Many marginalized communities in Nigeria, such as the disabled, the deaf, are sometimes overlooked in missions efforts. Pray for effective outreach to marginalized individuals and communities. Ask that the love of Christ be demonstrated to these oftenforgotten groups, and that they be fully included in the body of Christ. Receive grace for ministries working

among these groups.

Tuesday, October 22, 2024

Church planting efforts in hard-toreach areas face logistical, spiritual, and financial challenges. Pray for successful church planting efforts in difficult and remote areas. Ask that the Holy Spirit guide and strengthen church planters, providing them with every grace and resources they need to succeed. Pray for open doors for them.

Wednesday, October 23, 2024

Pray for the raising up of godly leaders and mature disciples in the Nigerian church. Strong discipleship and leadership training are essential for the long-term growth of the church. Ask for an outpouring of wisdom and grace on those leading discipleship and leadership development programs across the nation.

Thursday, October 24, 2024

Missionary families often face unique stressors, including long periods of separation, financial struggles, and emotional challenges. Pray for God's provision, strength, and peace for missionary families. Ask that they be united in purpose and filled with joy despite the challenges they face.

Friday, October 25, 2024

Testimonies abound of Muslims who are turning to Christ. Secret disciples and churches continue to grow in some Middle East nations. Thank God the for what He is doing among Muslims groups. Pray for the Safe

keeping of Muslim converts across world. Ask that the Lord our Strong tower will preserve, deliver them from every form of harm and help them continue to grow in Him.

Saturday, October 26, 2024

Pray for holistic transformation of missionary trainees in NEMA member agencies' missions schools. Pray that they be equipped for effective kingdom ministry and that God will make them into competent Kingdom Advocates. Also receive grace from the Lord for the trainers.

Sunday, October 27, 2024

Christ Kingdom Reigns Worldwide Mission

The ministry is engaged in outreaches and in mobilizing prayer efforts for the missions community. Ask for God's wisdom, strength, and breakthrough in difficult situations faced by missionaries. Pray for protection from harm and spiritual attacks, and ask for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the missions community, and for strength upon the weary. Plead for God's blessings upon the ministry.

Monday, October 28, 2024

Pray for women missionaries in Nigeria and across the world. They play a crucial role in missions, often serving in areas such as education, healthcare, and discipleship. Ask that God empower them for effective service and provide them with the support they need to thrive in their work. Pray that the Lord will raise more women to

be involved in missions.

Tuesday, October 29, 2024

God's Own Evangelistic Discipleship Ministry

God's Own Evangelistic Ministry provides free education for rural children and runs a sports outreach to bring converts to Christ. Pray for the success of their education program and for sponsorships for students now in university. Ask for God's guidance in discipling converts from the sports outreach and for the 2025 edition to be even more fruitful.

Wednesday, October 30, 2024

Nigeria still has over 43 unreached and least evangelised people groups who have limited access to the gospel. Pray God would raise up workers to go to these groups and share the gospel. Ask for open hearts and supernatural breakthroughs in these communities. Declare that ongoing gospel efforts among some these tribes will prosper.

Thursday, October 31, 2024

Effective training is key to preparing missionaries for the challenges they will face in the field. Pray for missionary training schools and programs across Nigeria, that they would be equipped with the necessary resources to provide thorough, Christ-centered preparation for those entering the mission field.

Friday, November 1, 2024

The Great Commission is an instruction to go make disciples and not just



converts. After conversion, it is essential for new believers to be discipled and grow in their faith. Pray that recent converts from different Christian endeavours would grow deep roots in their relationship with God, becoming mature in their faith. Ask that they would be well-discipled and grounded in the Word, and that their lives would bear lasting fruits.

Field Missionary Retreat 2024: Thank the Lord for Field Missionary Retreat which holds this month. Appreciate the Lord for His help over the planning.

Saturday, November 2, 2024

As the world keeps evolving, missions organizations are seeking new and innovative strategies to reach and disciple the unreached. Pray for divine inspiration and wisdom for missionaries and mission leaders as they plan and implement strategies to reach the lost. Ask the Lord to guide their efforts and to bring fruitfulness to their work.

Field Missionary Retreat 2024: The Lord is set and has promised to do great and mighty things. Appreciate Him for the mighty testimonies that will abound after the meeting.

Sunday, November 3, 2024

Many Christian workers serve in regions where they face hostility and danger for their faith. Pray for their protection and boldness, trusting God to open doors for the gospel even in the most difficult areas. Ask for

courage like the early church, that they may proclaim the message of Christ with boldness despite opposition.

Field Missionary Retreat 2024: Praise the Lord for the promise of His presence at the retreat. Thank the Lord for the renewal, the healing, the outpouring of grace and many other things the Lord will be doing in the meeting.

Monday, November 4, 2024

The Count Down to 30 Initiative, a strategy to promote the adoption and engagement of 13 out of the remaining 43 Unreached and Least Evangelised People Groups in Nigeria is still on. Pray for breakthroughs among these unreached groups, asking the Lord to soften hearts and prepare the way for the gospel. Pray for dedicated workers who will commit to long-term service among these people, and for resources to effectively reach them.

Field Missionary Retreat 2024: Pray that the presence of the Lord will be mighty as His people gather. Ask that there will be divine encounters and supernatural transformation of lives and ministries.

Tuesday, November 5, 2024

Missionary children often face unique challenges, including adapting to new cultures, frequent relocations, and separation from family. Pray for God's comfort and protection over missionary children. Ask that they will

develop a deep, personal relationship with Christ and thrive in their environments.

Field Missionary Retreat 2024:

Provisions are still much needed to host this meeting. Ask the Lord to open the heavens and supply every resource that is needed for a smooth execution of this strategic gathering. Wednesday, November 6, 2024

Thursday, November 7, 2024

Ask for the Blessings of God upon the missionary families looking to Him for the fruit of the womb. Pray that the Lord will bless them with their own children. Also pray for safe delivery for

those who are pregnant. Ask that the Lord will preserve the mother and baby(ies).

Field Missionary Retreat 2024:

Receive divine protection as missionaries travel from their fields to Abuja. Pray for their safety, especially for those who will pass through dangerous routes.

Friday, November 8, 2024

The Lord has been raising sons and daughters for Himself from among the Fulanis in Nigeria and other West African countries. Appreciate the Lord for the great testimonies from the people. The Fulanis remain a frontier people group with a dire need of concerted engagement efforts. Ask the Lord to open more doors of opportunities for their salvation. Pray that the missionaries already working among them will be encouraged, strengthened and preserved. Receive grace and fruitfulness for the efforts of NEMA Fulani Desk office.

Field Missionary Retreat 2024: Ask for fresh unction from the throne of grace for the speakers and everyone who will be handling one thing or the other at the meeting. Receive grace for the members of the Central Planning Committee.

Saturday, November 9, 2024

Pray for missionaries involved in technical support. Ask that the Spirit of Grace will make available strength and motivation as they work alongside with others to execute kingdom assignments.

Field Missionary Retreat 2024: Pray that as many missionaries who are losing sight of their God given assignment will be freshly and rightly envisioned again. Ask that there be divine restoration.

Sunday, November 10, 2024

Some mission fields are affected by wars, conflicts, or natural disasters, making it difficult for missionaries to continue their work. Pray for peace and resolution in areas of conflict, and for the safety of missionaries and the people. Ask God to intervene miraculously to bring restoration and healing where there is devastation.

Tuesday, November 12, 2024

A number of missionaries face physical and emotional exhaustion from their work in the field. This retreat is a time for them to rest and recharge. Pray for physical and emotional rest for the missionaries attending the retreat. Ask that their bodies and minds be restored and that they leave the retreat with renewed energy for the work ahead.

Wednesday, November 13, 2024

The speakers and facilitators at the retreat will play a critical role in bearing the mind of God to the missionaries. Pray for the speakers and facilitators at the retreat, asking God to fill them with wisdom and insight as they teach and minister. Ask that their words would be anointed and speak directly to the needs of the missionaries attending.

Thursday, November 14, 2024

Missionaries from different organizations and fields will gather

during the retreat, creating an opportunity for unity and collaboration in the missions community. Pray for unity among every missionary who will be at the retreat. Ask that this time would foster deeper relationships, cooperation, and mutual support as they work toward the same goal of reaching the nations for Christ.

Friday, November 15, 2024

Missionaries often carry heavy burdens in their work, and this retreat provides time for personal reflection, prayer, and seeking God's guidance. Pray for missionaries to have meaningful times of personal reflection during the retreat. Ask that God would speak clearly to each one, guiding their steps and encouraging their hearts as they seek His direction.

Saturday, November 16, 2024

Come against distraction of any kind, and against every tool of manipulation by the devil concerning the Field Missionary Retreat. Ask that the Lord will make the planning team sensitive to every evil plot and schemes of the devil and the enemy of the gospel.

Pray that the retreat would equip missionaries with resilience for future challenges. Ask that they will leave with strengthened faith and hope, prepared to face ministry adversity with courage.

Sunday, November 17, 2024

The Field Missionary Retreat is meant to be a time of spiritual renewal for missionaries, providing an opportunity for refreshment and rest in God's presence. Pray that every missionary attending the retreat will experience deep spiritual renewal. Ask for times of refreshing in God's presence, where their hearts are revived, and their commitment renewed.

Thank the Lord that the longanticipated day has arrived. Pray that as the retreat begins, missionaries will be inspired to model their lives and ministries after Jesus Christ. He will give hearing ears and understanding heart to the participants. Pray that the Lord will take control of everything that will be happening throughout the retreat.

Wednesday, November 20, 2024

Some of the missionaries came to the retreat wounded or weary, whether emotionally, physically, or spiritually, and are trusting God for of healing and restoration. Pray for healing and restoration for missionaries attending the retreat. Ask that God would touch every area of their lives that needs His healing power, bringing comfort and strength where there has been pain or discouragement.

Pray that the Lord will watch over the family and flocks that the missionaries left so as to be a part of the retreat.

Thursday, November 21, 2024

Appreciate the Lord for what He has being doing since the retreat started. Pray for an impactful conclusion to the retreat today, asking that all participants will leave with renewed vision, strength, and clarity for the future. Pray for safe travels as they prepare to return to their mission fields, bearing the life, virtues and encouragement they've received.

Friday, November 22, 2024

NEMA Annual General Assembly holds today. Receive grace for mission leaders, delegates and observers who will be participating in this year's AGA. Ask the Lord to take the lead in the gathering, and that it will birth renewed commitment for all missions leaders.

New member organisations will be accepted into the association today; receive grace for them to be

committed and faithful to the thrust and values of the association.

Saturday, November 23, 2024

Appreciate the Lord for the success of the Field Missionary Retreat 2024 and the Annual General Assembly. Give Him glory for the amazing things that only Him could have done, and the mighty testimonies we are already receiving. Pray that the Lord will watch over His words in our lives and continue to help and bless the Nigeria missions movement.

Sunday, November 24, 2024

CREMO Ministries

CREMO Ministries has work ongoing in Guinea Bissau and Djibouti, as well as among unreached groups within Nigeria. Thank God for the efforts in these regions and pray for success in their pioneer work in Guinea Bissau. Ask for God-called volunteers for their home mission fields. Pray for the completion of CREMO's regional headquarters project and the release of resources for it.

Monday, November 25, 2024

The families of missionaries, including spouses and children, face unique challenges as they serve in the field. Pray for missionary families to be strengthened and united in their calling. Ask that God would protect their relationships, provide for their needs, and give them joy and peace as they serve together. Receive peace and strength for missionary families going through difficult times.

Tuesday, November 26, 2024

A number of missionaries rely on financial support from churches and individuals to sustain their work in the field. Pray that missionaries would receive sustained and generous financial support to meet their personal needs and ministry goals. Ask that God would provide abundantly for them and bless those who give.

Wednesday, November 27, 2024

Urban areas present unique challenges and opportunities for evangelism, as missionaries work to reach diverse populations. Pray for missionaries and church leaders to develop innovative and effective strategies for reaching people in urban centers with the gospel. Ask for wisdom and creativity as they engage with people from different backgrounds and cultures.

Thursday, November 28, 2024

Conflict and unrest in many regions have led to the displacement of thousands of people within Nigeria and neighbouring countries. Pray for ministries serving refugees and internally displaced people. Ask that the people would experience God's love through the care they receive and find hope in the gospel.

Friday, November 29, 2024

Pray for open doors to share the gospel in Muslim-majority regions. Ask that God will create opportunities for missionaries and believers to share the gospel in the Muslim world. Ask that

hearts will be softened and that many Muslims will come to know the saving power of Jesus Christ. Pray that there will be divine encounters as they go for Juma'at today.

Saturday, November 30, 2024

Church leaders play crucial roles in encouraging and equipping their congregations to engage in missions, both locally and globally. Pray for church leaders across Nigeria to embrace their role as missions champions, leading their congregations to pray, give, and go. Ask that they receive fresh vision and passion for the Great Commission.

Sunday, December 1, 2024

As we enter the last month of the year, take time to reflect on God's faithfulness throughout 2024. Thank God for His protection, provision, and guidance over the course of the year. Praise Him for the victories won and the souls saved in various mission fields across Nigeria and beyond.

Monday, December 2, 2024

Give thanks to God for the success of **HarvestScope 1.0** and **2.0**, which have significantly contributed to advancing the reaping of the remaining harvest fields. Pray for the upcoming unveiling of **HarvestScope 3.0**, ask the Lord to pour out favour, wisdom, and strategic access upon the research team. Pray that this research will accelerate mission efforts and bring clarity to the task ahead.

Tuesday, December 3, 2024

International Day of Persons with Disabilities.

Over 1 billion people worldwide live with some form of disability, facing challenges related to accessibility, discrimination, and inclusion. Pray for greater inclusion and equal opportunities for persons with disabilities. Ask that they may experience dignity and respect in all areas of life. Pray that the Church would lead in creating communities where everyone is valued, loved, and empowered to contribute to the Kingdom of God.

Wednesday, December 4, 2024

Missionary Support and Empowerment Ministry International

The ministry is preparing for a mission outreach to Niger and Kebbi States during Christmas. Pray for God's presence to guide and protect the team. Ask for provision of resources for the outreach, and that the hearts of people will be opened to the gospel. Pray for sponsors to help build churches in the places they reach and for safety during the journey.

Thursday, December 5, 2024

There are a number of planned Christmas outreaches by NEMA member agencies and other Christian groups. Pray for effective planning and mobilization of resources for the various Christmas outreach efforts. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide every step and for open hearts to receive the message of Christ. Pray for ultimate success of these programs.

Friday, December 6, 2024

Muslims believe in the uniqueness of an all-powerful and supreme God. Similar to Christians and Jews, they believe that God is creative and eternal. But Muslims also believe that God is unknowable, making a personal relationship with Him impossible. According to Islam, God holds himself apart from mankind. Pray that Muslims will have a full revelation of God's character and desire for relationship especially as they observe the Jumaat service today.

Saturday, December 7, 2024

Pray that church leaders and Christian elders will remain above reproach, walking in integrity and godliness. Ask the Lord to guard them from temptation, complacency, and the lure of worldliness. Plead on their behalf that their testimonies will remain pure and untarnished, and that they will finish their race strong, bringing glory to God in all they do.

Sunday, December 8, 2024

Business professionals have unique opportunities to share the gospel through their work, especially in regions where traditional missions is restricted. Pray for Christian business professionals to see their work as a platform for missions. Ask that they

boldly share their faith in their workplaces and use their influence to advance the kingdom of God.

Monday, December 9, 2024

The call of Jesus to His disciples is to first be with Him and then He might send them to preach (Mark 3:13). Believers and gospel labourers could sometimes be overwhelmed with ministerial activities so much that their spiritual disciplines and fellowship deplete. Pray that the Lord will help us to set and get our priorities right. Ask that relationship with Jesus will be the utmost priority of His children.

Tuesday, December 10, 2024

"Christ is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ. To this end I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me." (Colossians 1:28-29).

Pray that the preachers of the gospel will in all faithfulness preach Christ and Him alone. Also pray that their presentation of the Gospel of Christ will be done in the power of the Holy Ghost.

Wednesday, December 11, 2024

Pastors and Church leaders in rural communities face enormous pressure and responsibility. Pray for wisdom, strength, and encouragement for these leaders. Ask for God's provision for their needs and that they will be empowered to lead with grace and humility.

Thursday, December 12, 2024

To make ends meet, some missionaries have gone into different kinds of businesses. Some are able to manage this well with their primary assignment on the field, while some others are not. There have been reports of missionaries who left their fields and got fully engaged in the business as it grows. Pray for grace for balance for missionaries who necessarily need to do this. Come against every form of distraction that gospel workers might be facing.

Friday, December 13, 2024

West Africa is home to a large Muslim population, many of whom have heard but are yet to respond to the gospel. Pray for the spread of the gospel among Muslims in West Africa. Ask that God would raise up Christian workers to minister in this region and that many Muslims would come to know Christ as Lord.

Saturday, December 14, 2024

Many missionaries face health challenges due to difficult living conditions and the nature of their work. Pray for the physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being of missionaries. Ask for divine healing for those who are sick and for God's protection over their health.

Sunday, December 15, 2024

Many missionaries will be spending Christmas in the field, away from their loved ones. Pray for comfort and strength for missionaries in this category. Ask for God's presence to be with them and for their joy to be renewed as they serve others. Pray for provision of all that will needed to have a good celebration.

Monday, December 16, 2024

Indigenous missionaries, those from within the cultural groups they serve, often have unique advantages in reaching their people (Matt 13:53-58). Pray for the empowerment and support of indigenous missionaries in Nigeria and other nations. Ask the Lord to make them a voice and to cause their people to listen to them. Let the Lord raise up many more from within the communities to share the gospel effectively.

Tuesday, December 17, 2024

As urban centers in Nigeria keep growing, there abounds opportunities and challenges for evangelism in these bustling environments. Pray for effective evangelism in Nigeria's urban areas. Ask that Christians living in cities be bold witnesses for Christ in their workplaces, neighbourhoods, and communities. Pray for innovative ways to reach people in these settings.

Wednesday, December 18, 2024

International Migrants Day

As of 2023, over 281 million people live outside their countries of origin, driven by conflict, economic hardship, or environmental factors. International Migrants Day was established by the United Nations to recognize the

contributions and challenges faced by migrants globally. Pray for the protection, provision, and dignity of migrants worldwide. Pray that they may find safety, community, and hope amidst their challenges. Ask for compassionate policies and responses from governments and communities that reflect God's love for the displaced.

Thursday, December 19, 2024

According to Countrymeter, 211 people migrate daily in Nigeria, which amounts to 8 people per hour. Most of this migration occurs from the North to the Southern regions of the country. Many migrants feel lost and lonely, far from their homelands, and would greatly appreciate the love and care of Christians. Unfortunately, some southern Christians still harbor apathy towards northerners, which negatively impacts evangelization efforts. Pray that God will soften our hearts, making us more hospitable to migrants and strangers, so we can clearly express the love of Jesus Christ.

Friday, December 20, 2024

The gospel continues to make progress

in Muslim communities, but there is still much work to be done. Pray for increased opportunities to reach Muslims with the gospel. Declare that government policies in core Islamic nations that make gospel heralding difficult be changed. Receive boldness and wisdom for missionaries working among Muslim populations.

Saturday, December 21, 2024

A number of missionaries serve in countries where the gospel is not openly welcomed, and often under great risk. Pray for divine protection and boldness for missionaries serving in creative access nations. Ask for God to provide wisdom as they share the gospel and for favour with local authorities and communities.

Sunday, December 22, 2024

Rural churches sometimes struggle due to inadequate number of trained leaders and of resources. Pray for the growth and strengthening of rural churches. Ask God to raise and multiply committed leaders, provide resources, and bless these congregations with unity and vision for the future.

Monday, December 23, 2024

As we approach the festive season, many people will be moving from different places to the other. Pray that during these movements, many will come in contact with Christ, the reason for the season. Pray that witnessing believers will take advantage of this season to proclaim and demonstrate

One of the many traditions around this period is singing of carol hymns and reading of the Nine Lessons. Ask the Lord to speak to many hearts who will come across the renditions and the readings this year. Make a commitment to the Lord to win at least a soul in this season.

Today we celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ, the Saviour of the world.

Pray that the true meaning of Christmas will be known around the world today. Ask that the celebration of Christ's birth would open doors for the gospel to be shared and accepted by those who have yet to know Him. *Merry Christmas to you and all yours.*

Thursday, December 26, 2024

A number of Nigerian youths are facing societal challenges but are also being drawn toward a renewed interest in faith and purpose. Pray for a sweeping revival among Nigerian youths, that they will turn to God in greater numbers. Ask for churches and mission organizations to effectively reach and disciple them.

Friday, December 27, 2024

The potency of Christian radio ministry is acknowledged, especially in the North. Pray that the various studios from whence Christian radio contents are broadcast will receive help from God. Pray that the broadcasters and

content creators will constantly be under the influence of the Holy Spirit.

Saturday, December 28, 2024

Many communities are still waiting for the Bible to be translated into their native languages. Pray for Bible translation teams working tirelessly to make God's Word available to unreached people groups. Ask for accuracy, speed, and protection for those involved in translation projects.

Spiritual warfare on the mission field is real. Pray for strength and protection over missionaries engaged in spiritual warfare. Ask for God's power to overcome the forces of darkness and for His presence to reign in difficult mission fields.

As mission organizations prepare for the new year, pray for clarity and insight in their planning. Ask that their strategies and goals align with God's purposes, leading to effective evangelism and discipleship. Pray that their efforts will be guided by divine wisdom and result in abundant fruitfulness for the Kingdom of God.

Tuesday, December 31, 2024

Today is the last day of the year 2024. Through many dangers, toils and snares, the grace of the Lord has brought us thus far. Take some time to reflect on the many blessings of the Lord and thank Him from the depth of your heart. Make a commitment to the

This small store is gradually becoming a connection between the missionary and the people. Pray that God will continue to provide for the restocking of the store with the kinds of drugs the people need. Pray also that God will enable the team to discover the person of peace among their customers, and grant a breakthrough among the people.

Saturday, January 18, 2025

Pray for global peace especially in areas of unrest and wars as this poses a great threat to the expansion of the kingdom of God. Pray for God's intervention in these troubled areas. Declare a restoration of peace, and wisdom to maintain it.

Sunday, January 19, 2025
