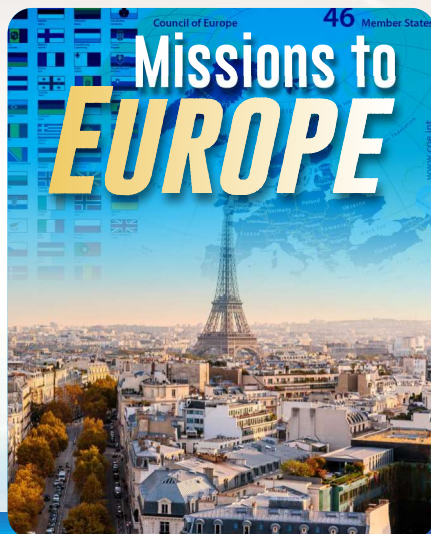
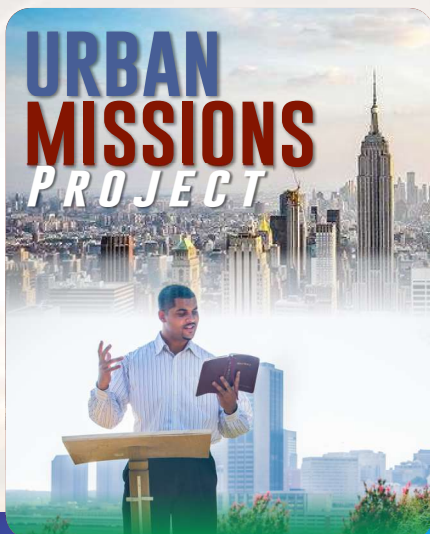
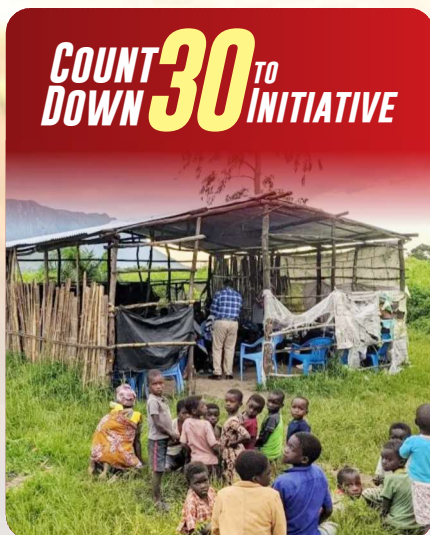

### JUNE 2025

#### Sunday, June 1, 2025

*"Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His love endures forever."* – Psalm 107:1 (NIV)

## **Tuesday, June 17, 2025**

Pray that participants of the Urban Missions Consultation will come with open hearts and leave with fresh vision, clarity, and commitment to urban missions. Ask that the gathering will occasion revival in different dimensions.

## **Wednesday, June 18, 2025**

As the consultation begins today at Chapel of Christ Our Light, UNILAG, pray that God will meet with His people powerfully. Ask that participants will truly see the city as ripe for harvest and receive divine strategies for transforming urban centers for Christ.

## **Thursday, June 19, 2025**

Praise the Lord for how greatly He began with us yesterday at the Urban Missions Consultation. As the meeting concludes today, pray that every participant will leave with a renewed burden, clear next steps, and practical commitments. ## **Friday, June 20, 2025**

Give thanks for the skills acquisition initiative introduced at NEMI and its impact so far. Pray that current missionary trainees will take this training seriously and apply the skills effectively on the field. Ask the Lord to use these skills to promote self-sufficiency, reduce dependence on external support, and address key challenges that often lead to missionary attrition.





### **Saturday, June 21, 2025**

Ask the Lord to grant our lawmakers divine wisdom and a deep sense of responsibility as they make decisions that shape the nation. Pray that they will allocate Nigeria's resources with integrity, equity, and foresight, promoting justice, development, and the well-being of all citizens.

### **Sunday, June 22, 2025**

Pray that the Lord will grant missionaries and mission leaders hearts that are humble, pure, and fully aligned with His will. Ask that Jesus becomes our daily model, not just in ministry strategy, but in character, sacrifice, and servant leadership.

### **Monday, June 23, 2025**

Ask God to raise up faithful individuals, churches, and businesses who will commit to providing consistent financial and material support for missions. Pray that the spirit of generosity will flourish, and that every genuine Kingdom work will have the resources needed to thrive and advance.

### **Tuesday, June 24, 2025**

As leaders and stakeholders prepare for the Nigeria Missions Executive Congress and AGA in November

2025, pray for a fresh move of God that will stir vision, collaboration, and sacrificial commitment to reaching the unreached. Ask that the Holy Spirit will direct every session toward decisions that will advance the fulfillment of the Great Commission in Nigeria and beyond. ### **Wednesday, June 25, 2025**

Lift up Christian communities across the Middle East. Ask God to protect them from violence, discrimination, and oppression. Pray for His sustaining grace, provision of resources, and open doors for them to thrive spiritually, economically, and socially.

### **Thursday, June 26, 2025**

Lift up the ongoing construction of the Female Hostel at the Nigeria Evangelical Missionary Institute (NEMI). Ask the Lord to provide all the needed resources—financial, material, and human—to complete the project excellently and on time. Pray that the hostel will become a safe, nurturing space that supports the growth and equipping of women for effective missionary service.



## Friday, June 27, 2025

**Islamic New Year (Al-Hijra).** As Muslims around the world mark the beginning of a new year today, pray that this season will stir a deeper spiritual hunger in their hearts. Ask the Lord to reveal Jesus, the Way, the Truth, and the Life to sincere seekers.

## Saturday, June 28, 2025

Thank God for the creative outreach efforts to Algerians through radio, literature, satellite TV, portable media, and Bible correspondence courses. As pressure on the Church continues to increase in 2025, pray for strength, wisdom, and boldness for believers. Pray for more Christian resources in local languages and accessible formats that will help the persecuted Church.

## Sunday, June 29, 2025

Thank God for the growth of the Church in Côte d'Ivoire, especially the steady rise of evangelical and charismatic movements, even in times of conflict. Pray for deep discipleship and a strong return to sound biblical teaching across all denominations. Ask the Lord to raise leaders who prioritize Christ above prosperity or signs, and to ignite a hunger for God's Word among believers.

## Monday, June 30, 2025

Ask the Lord to show great mercy over Northern Nigeria, where insurgency and violence is still raging. Pray that He will stretch forth His hand to calm troubled regions, silence the voice of terror, and bring lasting peace. Intercede for healing in wounded communities, comfort for the afflicted, and the restoration of hope to the land.

## JULY 2025

## Tuesday, July 1, 2025

Thank God for His faithfulness through the first half of the year. As we step into the second half, commit every mission effort, church activity, and Kingdom assignment into His hands. Pray for renewed strength for missionaries, fresh vision for church leaders, and multiplied fruitfulness in every field of labour. Ask the Lord to perfect all that concerns His people in the months ahead.

## Wednesday, July 2, 2025

Intercede for mission efforts that are stalled due to financial delay. Ask for supernatural breakthroughs, the release of held-back resources, and divine connections to funding channels that align with God's purposes.



## Thursday, July 3, 2025

Ask the Lord to pour out the spirit of excellence, anointing, and relevance upon all NEMI and NEMA training programs. Pray that these efforts will effectively equip a new generation of competent and Spirit-led cross-cultural workers.

## Friday, July 4, 2025

Pray that more Muslims will be drawn to Christ, especially those disillusioned by violence. Ask the Lord to strengthen the Church and equip believers to lovingly and wisely share the gospel with Muslims around them.

## Saturday, July 5, 2025

Thank God for mission-minded churches and the vital role they play in advancing God's Kingdom. Pray that more church leaders will embrace the Great Commission, making Christ central in their preaching and leading their congregations to engage in reaching the unreached.

## Sunday, July 6, 2025

Thank the Lord for the progress made so far through NEMA's four core emphasis this season: **Count Down to 30, Vision 5015 Plus, Missions to Europe, and Urban Missions.** Pray for widespread

understanding, acceptance, and ownership of these initiatives by the Nigerian Church. Ask God to stir a deep commitment in leaders and congregations toward their full implementation and fruitfulness.

## Monday, July 7, 2025

Missionaries often need re-training to stay effective, yet many are hindered by lack of funds and other challenges. Ask God to open doors of favour and provide support through people, churches, and unexpected channels. Pray that no missionary will be denied the equipping they need to thrive in their calling.

## Tuesday, July 8, 2025

Lift up the families of missionaries-spouses, children, and loved ones. Pray that they will be a source of strength, encouragement, and emotional support. Ask the Lord to guard their unity, meet their needs, and use them as a testimony of His faithfulness.

## Wednesday, July 9, 2025

Ask the Lord to stir His Church with a deep, active love for the unsaved and new converts; one that moves beyond words into action. Pray that believers will be driven to seek the lost and disciple new believers



faithfully. Declare that the Church walk in her true calling, showing faith through love and selfless service.

### **Thursday, July 10, 2025**

Pray that the Lord will open the eyes of Christians living and working in Urban areas to recognise the gospel opportunities around them and be moved to make disciples who will also disciple others.

### **Friday, July 11, 2025**

Pray that the Holy Spirit will gently lead Muslims to see that true honour is found in knowing and following Jesus, the Truth. Ask that cultural barriers be softened, and that Christ's love and righteousness will speak louder than fear or shame.

### **Saturday, July 12, 2025**

Ask the Lord to multiply gracious and compassionate mission leaders who will patiently disciple and encourage younger missionaries. Pray that both leaders and the led will remain sensitive to the Holy Spirit's guidance, leaning not solely on experience, but walking in fresh revelation and obedience at all times.

### **Sunday, July 13, 2025**

Ask the Lord to empower all ongoing and emerging church planting efforts, especially among unreached people groups and hard-to-reach regions within and outside Nigeria. Pray for effectiveness in discipleship and the emergence of indigenous, Spirit-led leaders who will sustain the mission work in new fields.

### **Monday, July 14, 2025**

Thank God for the gathering of NEMA's National Executive Committee starting today. Pray for divine wisdom, unity, and clarity of direction as they deliberate on matters critical to the advancement of missions. Ask that every decision made will align with God's will and accelerate the fulfilment of the Great Commission through the Nigerian Church.

### **Tuesday, July 15, 2025**

Ask God for supernatural breakthroughs in Nigeria's unreached regions where the Gospel has long faced resistance. Pray that spiritual strongholds will be broken, hearts softened, and that God's light will penetrate every dark corner.



## Wednesday, July 16, 2025

Thank God for the increasing number of young people responding to His call to missions, especially through Short-term mission trips. Pray that they will be filled with courage and clarity as they take bold steps into long-term service. Ask the Lord to provide them with quality training, godly mentors, and strong support systems to thrive and endure in this path.

## Thursday, July 17, 2025

Pray against the spirit of division that plagues our land, especially in the villages. Ask that in God's mercy, He will unite the diverse tribes and people groups of Nigeria. Pray that the tribes and communities will live together in humility and love, seeking the common good and the peace of our nation. Pray that the Church among these tribes will lead the way in modelling reconciliation and unity.

## Friday, July 18, 2025

Comoros remains overwhelmingly Muslim, with rising Islamic fundamentalism and widespread occult practices. Many young people, disillusioned by hopelessness, turn to drugs, immorality, or seek escape abroad. Pray that God will break through this darkness with the gospel of life. Ask the Lord to create open doors for the message of hope in Christ to reach hearts longing for truth and meaning.

## Saturday, July 19, 2025

As engagement continues among the **Count Down to 30** target tribes, ask the Lord to prepare hearts within these communities and grant divine access for fruitful disciple-making. Declare a collapse to every gospel barrier.

## Sunday, July 20, 2025

Many missionaries daily face threats—banditry, illness, persecution, etc. Stand in the gap for them today by declaring Psalm 91: that the Lord will be their refuge and fortress, covering them with His feathers and commanding His angels to guard them in all their ways. Pray for supernatural protection and peace in every location they serve.





### Monday, July 21, 2025

Unreached peoples are still globally described as ethnic groups without an indigenous, self-propagating Christian or church movement. The Countdown to 30 initiative aims to reduce the 43 unreached and least evangelised people groups in Nigeria to 13 by December 2025. Pray that God quickens the hearts of men to respond to the adoption and engagement of the target tribes by praying, going, sending, and giving.

### Tuesday, July 22, 2025

Lift up the children of missionaries before the Lord. Pray for strong spiritual foundations, grace over their education, meaningful friendships, and a deep sense of stability and joy amidst different transitions. Ask that they grow to love the Lord and find purpose in their unique journey.

### Wednesday, July 23, 2025

Ask God to stir the hearts of churches and agencies across Nigeria, and also give burdens to individuals and families to adopt and engage the target tribes under the Count Down to 30 Initiative.

### Thursday, July 24, 2025

Distraction is a real challenge in missions. Ask God to remove every form of distraction, especially the busyness of activities that keeps believers from fully engaging in the Great Commission. Pray for clarity, focus, and a renewed sense of purpose in fulfilling Christ's mandate.

### Friday, July 25, 2025

Pray for the emergence of bold, indigenous Gospel movements within the Muslim world, such that is deeply rooted in Scripture, culturally relevant, and led by Spirit-filled believers. Ask that these movements multiply disciples who passionately love, follow, and proclaim Jesus within their communities and beyond.

### Saturday, July 26, 2025

Intercede for a fresh move of God across Europe. Pray for a deep spiritual awakening among diaspora communities, secular youth, and those shaped by post-Christian worldviews—that hearts will be stirred to seek truth and encounter Jesus.



## Sunday, July 27, 2025

Pray for strong, Spirit-led partnerships between African churches and European believers. Ask that these collaborations be marked by humility, unity, and a shared passion to make disciples and advance God's kingdom across Europe.

## Monday, July 28, 2025

Nigeria Missions Executive Congress (NIMEC) 2025 is less than five months away. Ask the Lord to grant unity of purpose, clarity of direction, and a strong sense of God's leading throughout the Congress, so that every session, conversation, and decision will align with Heaven's agenda.

## AUGUST 2025

## Friday, August 1

*Psalms 103:2 – "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits."*

Give thanks to God for His faithfulness throughout the past months. Commit the month of August into His hands, ask for open doors, divine guidance, and abundant fruitfulness in every mission endeavour.



## **Saturday, August 2**

Pray that God will continue to stir the hearts of young people to answer the call to missions. Ask for proper mentorship and discipleship structures to nurture their zeal into lasting obedience.

## **Sunday, August 3**

Thank God for churches that are actively sending and supporting missionaries. Pray for a deeper understanding of the Great Commission across congregations and complete obedience to it.

## **Monday, August 4**

Pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send more labourers into Nigeria's mission fields, especially to unreached, least evangelised people groups and unchurched places. Ask for supernatural breakthroughs, divine encounters, and hearts opened to the Gospel in these regions.

## **Tuesday, August 5**

Pray for the work of Bible translators and Scripture Engagement teams across Nigeria. Ask the Lord to remove every linguistic, cultural, and logistical barrier. Pray that the vision of making God's Word available in every heart language will be fulfilled, leading to deep transformation and

multiplication of obedient disciples.

## **Wednesday, August 6**

Pray for missionaries serving in difficult and hostile environments. Ask the Lord to strengthen them physically, emotionally, and spiritually. Pray for healing where there is pain, protection where there is danger, and renewed vision where hope is fading. Ask God to surround them with supportive community and encouragement.

## **Thursday, August 7**

As cities expand, the harvest fields enlarge. Pray that churches and missionaries will perceive this urban growth through God's eyes and be inspired to create innovative, Spirit-led strategies for reaching diverse populations in urban centres with the Gospel.

## **Friday, August 8**

Pray that the spiritual hunger stirred by the emptiness of postmodern relativism in France will lead many to seek lasting truth in Christ. Ask God to equip believers to patiently and relationally share the hope of Jesus with those searching for meaning, overcoming suspicion and resistance to religion.



### **Saturday, August 9**

**NEMA's Four Core Emphasis:** Lift up the Count Down to 30, Vision 5015+, Missions to Europe, and Urban Missions Initiative. Pray for clarity, unity, and effectiveness as NEMA and its members pursue these kingdom goals.

### **Sunday, August 10**

#### **Nigeria Missions Executive Congress (NIMEC 2025)**

Pray that discipleship will move beyond structured programs to becoming a daily lifestyle of following Jesus. Ask the Lord to raise passionate, multiplying disciples who intentionally make other disciples across families, campuses, workplaces, and communities.

### **Tuesday, August 12**

Lift mission training institutes before the Lord. Pray for grace, wisdom, and excellence upon the leadership and faculty. Intercede for missionary trainees to have humble, teachable hearts, eager to walk in the footsteps of Jesus. Ask God to meet every material, spiritual, and financial needs of both trainers and trainees.

### **Wednesday, August 13**

Pray for Christian students across the nation. Ask the Lord to guide and strengthen those who love and follow Him, empower them to be bold witnesses and compassionate friends to others who are searching for truth and spiritual growth. Also, pray for their protection and perseverance amid the challenges and pressures of campus life.

### **Thursday, August 14**

Muslims fear God and often wonder if they have done enough to please Him. The Quran teaches that God is always watching (4:1, 33:52), and many hope their good deeds will outweigh their bad, though salvation is never guaranteed. Pray that Muslims will come to see God as a compassionate Father who loves them deeply. Pray they will embrace Jesus' perfect love, which casts out fear. Ask God to replace their fear



with His Spirit of power, love, and self-control.

## Friday, August 15

Germany has 64% claiming Christianity, but many see religion as irrelevant. Only 14% attend church regularly, but about 2% truly follow Jesus. Germany and France now have the largest Muslim populations in Europe, with around five million Muslims in Germany. Pray for a second Reformation to make the Church culturally relevant and Biblically sound. Also, ask for spiritual awakening among the lost youths in the country.

## Saturday, August 16

Liechtenstein is a constitutional principality with deep Catholic roots, though many native citizens are not actively practicing. The Muslim and non-religious populations are growing. Since 1985, an evangelical fellowship, started by British, Norwegian, and Swiss believers, has been active. Some members of the royal family are involved in the Catholic charismatic renewal and profess personal faith in Christ. Pray that the disinterested and irreligious will be awakened to their need for a personal Savior. Ask God to illuminate the eyes of the financially secure to their spiritual need and

eternal hope in Christ.

## Sunday, August 17

Pray that, like the sincere faith of Lois and Eunice that shaped Timothy (2 Tim. 1:5), missionary parents will be empowered to live faithfully before God, creating a lasting heritage of faith for their children, grandchildren, and generations yet to come.

## Monday, August 18

*Count Down to 30* is a strategic missions initiative calling for the adoption and engagement of 13 out of the remaining known Nigeria's 43 unreached and least evangelized people groups by individuals, families, Churches and Christian organisations. Declare a gospel breakthrough among these tribes and the birthing of disciple making movement among them.

## Tuesday, August 19

Thank the Lord for the revival already happening in Europe. Pray that there will be more. Pray that there will be a fresh outpouring of God's Spirit upon the continent to destroy all the activities of Satan





working actively to erase the many years of the impact of the Christian faith. Pray for abundant fruits from all the seeds that have been sown in the past years and presently.

## Wednesday, August 20

Over 53% of Nigerians live in urban areas, and this is projected to rise above 70% by 2050. Pray that the church will rise to maximise this divine opportunity to engage those without the gospel who now live in our cities. Pray for inspired engagements and resources to effectively reach this growing urban population in Nigeria and around the world.

## Thursday, August 21

Declare access and open doors upon the nations that are completely closed to the Gospel among the Vision 5015 Plus nations. Pray also for Nigerian professionals working in various restricted countries that they will use their professions to seek out opportunities for sharing the gospel.

## Friday, August 22

In Denmark, over 80% identify as Lutheran, but only 2% attend church regularly, and half of them say they are agnostic or atheist. Other Christian groups raise the total Christian populace to about 85%. Nearly 4% of the population is Muslim, making Islam the second largest religion.

Pray that many Danes will rediscover the faith that shaped their nation's history and society.

## Saturday, August 23

Pray that the Lord would release His truth powerfully in secondary schools and tertiary institutions. Ask Him to help students discern truth accurately and guard them from believing false teachings, even as they seek God. Receive grace for teachers at all levels.

## Sunday, August 24

Pray that every positive prophecy hanging over Nigeria shall come to pass. Ask that the nation will experience true transformation, and that the Lord will give Nigeria a new name.



## Monday, August 25

Pray that Christians facing persecution for their faith in different parts of the world will be filled with supernatural strength, courage, and perseverance. Ask the Lord to help them remain steadfast in faith and to hold on to His promises even in the face of threats, hardship, or isolation.

## Tuesday, August 26

Pray that God will release abundant resources for the planning and execution of mission projects, outreaches, and strategic programs. Ask for open doors of provision so that no assignment is hindered due to lack of funds (Philippians 4:19)

## Wednesday, August 27

Pray for innovative strategies and greater impact in urban missions across African megacities, especially among youth, professionals, and marginalized groups. Ask God to stir a fresh wave of mobilization across churches, campuses, and denominations, raising up goers, senders, intercessors, and generous givers.

## Thursday, August 28

Give thanks to the Lord for conquering evil and the Holy Spirit for His constant presence and help. Pray that Christians be filled with

power and strength, as their minds and spirits are equipped to resist and overcome Satan's deception.

## Friday, August 29

Finland's society is largely secular, though about two-thirds identify as Christian. While 90% appreciate the Church's social work, only 8% attend services regularly. A strong belief in human reason and rejection of the supernatural prevail. Pray for a spiritual breakthrough, bringing both reformation within the Church and fresh expressions of faith, leading many to seek the Lord.

## Saturday, August 30

Pray for unity, trust, and effective synergy among mission agencies, churches, and networks partnering with NEMA, resulting in greater fruitfulness and shared resources. Ask God to release financial and material provision for all NEMA-led initiatives and projects.

## Sunday, August 31

Give thanks to God for the support already received toward the ongoing female hostel construction project in NEMI. Pray for more partners and resources to complete the building. Ask the Lord for continuous



provision for all ongoing projects in missions training institutes, that they may foster holistic formation and life-transforming impact.

## SEPTEMBER 2025

### Monday, September 1

Thank God for the gift of a new month and the start of the final quarter of the year. Appreciate His blessings, grace, and faithfulness over your life, ministry, and all He has entrusted to you. Celebrate the gift of life and the privilege to partner with Him in His mission.

### Tuesday, September 2

**November 18–20, 2025**, the biennial Nigeria Missions Executive Congress (NIMEC) will be held in Jos. Pray that God's breath will rest upon this strategic and equipping gathering of mission leaders. Ask the Lord to guide every aspect of the planning process and reveal His mind clearly to all participants. Pray that the Congress will birth fresh vision, unity, and momentum for finishing the task from Nigeria. Regular registration closes September 30, 2025. ### Wednesday, September 3

Ask the Lord to use us as faithful labourers in His harvest fields. Pray that we will walk in the power of Christ who lives in us and is greater than the enemy. Ask for strength to fight the good fight and advance God's Kingdom into places still held by darkness.

### Thursday, September 4

Pray for the Senate and Houses of Representatives as they make laws to govern our land. Ask that the spirit of truth, fairness and justice will prevail in their deliberations and decisions.

### Friday, September 5

Pray against the crippling fatalism in Islam that leads many to silently endure pain and shame. Ask God to bring deliverance to those suffering both physically and spiritually. Pray that oppressors encounter the saving grace of Jesus Christ and find true freedom. Ask the Lord to open the eyes of Muslims to the truth that Jesus is God and the source of eternal hope.

### Saturday, September 6

Ask God to be a shield around His children, protect them from physical harm, unjust imprisonment, and violence. Pray for miraculous escapes



for hostages, divine interventions in dangerous situations, and for those in hiding to remain invisible to those who seek to harm them.

## Sunday, September 7

King Salman, the absolute monarch of Saudi Arabia and Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, is a key figure in the Islamic world. Pray for a soft and open heart toward the Gospel amid his declining health. Ask God to bring transformative encounters with global Christian leaders that challenge his faith in Islam and open the way for truth and salvation.

## Monday, September 8

Ask God to keep His breath upon missionary training institutes in Nigeria and beyond. Pray that they will uphold the purity and purpose of their curriculum and training schedules, resisting pressure to compromise or conform to trends that dilute their original mandate. Pray that they remain faithful to equipping missionaries for effective Christian service.

## Tuesday, September 9

**Daoism** teaches belief in many gods, once human, who gained divine status through meditation and spiritual practices. These gods

are not eternal, omnipotent, or creators. But Scripture declares, *"The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth"* (Isaiah 40:28). Pray for freedom from divination, spiritism, and magic that bind many in demonic oppression. Pray also that the truth of God's eternal nature and creative power will pierce through spiritual confusion.

## Wednesday, September 10

**Mormonism:** Members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS), or Mormons, show deep devotion to Jesus, yet their core beliefs differ significantly from biblical Christianity. They reject the Trinity and also teach that humans can become gods, which contradicts the Bible's teaching that God alone is eternal and all-powerful (Isaiah 43:10). Pray for Mormons to develop a deep hunger for biblical truth. Ask God to unveil deception and reveal the true Gospel to them.

## Thursday, September 11

**Jainism:** Jains believe the soul (jiva) goes through cycles of reincarnation, seeking enlightenment by eliminating all karma. A soul that reaches this state becomes a god with unlimited



knowledge and bliss, but cannot help others. There are no higher beings to guide humans. Rebirth is based on karma—good or bad deeds from one's life. But the Bible says, *"It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment..."* (Hebrews 9:27). Pray for Jains to see the futility of striving for salvation through karma and recognize their need for a Saviour.

## Friday, September 12

**Sikhism:** Sikhs may honour Jesus as a prophet or spiritual teacher, but do not believe He is God, as they hold that God cannot take human form or be born. Yet the Bible reveals that *"The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and Only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth"* (John 1:14). Pray that Sikh individuals will come to recognize Jesus not just as a great teacher, but as God in the flesh—full of grace and truth, the only way to truly know the Father.

## Saturday, September 13

Lift up people who are grieving the loss of loved ones, homes, churches, or communities due to persecution. Pray that the Holy Spirit, the Comforter, will bring deep healing

to their hearts and restore joy and hope.

## Sunday, September 14

Lift up Nigerian missionaries serving across Europe to God, pray for grace to adapt culturally, gain favour with host communities, and experience a mighty move of God in both Diaspora churches and increasingly secular cities. Ask God to divinely connect prospective missionaries to "men of peace" as they prepare to saturate Europe with the Gospel, wherever their feet tread.

## Monday, September 15

Pray for the expanding use of diverse media—films, social media platforms, prints, radio/TV, and podcasts, to creatively and effectively proclaim the gospel across Nigeria and beyond. Ask God to inspire innovative contents that resonate with all generations, breaking barriers and reaching unreached communities with the message of hope and salvation.

## Tuesday, September 16

Pray that local churches in Northern Nigeria will remain steadfast in faith, grow in boldness, and shine as strong lights of hope and truth in their communities. Also commit the Pastors providing leadership for





these churches to the Lord.

## **Wednesday, September 17**

Integrity and stewardship are important virtues. Lift mission leaders and finance teams, asking God to grant them grace to steward God's resources with integrity, transparency, and accountability. Pray that every resource will be used effectively for Kingdom advancement.

## **Thursday, September 18**

Discipleship in many churches today is being reduced to mere programs and meetings. Pray that discipleship will go beyond programs and become a lifestyle. Ask the Lord to raise multiplying disciples who make other disciples across families, campuses, and communities.

Imams deliver the khutba (sermon) on Fridays and lead their communities with deep knowledge of the Quran and strong respect. Pray that Imams and Muslim leaders

will encounter the glory and love of Jesus and be transformed by His grace. Pray for them to have courage to flee darkness and to embrace the light, truth, and freedom found in Jesus.

## **Saturday, September 20**

Ask the Lord to raise committed individuals, churches, and organisations who will joyfully and faithfully give towards missions. Pray that a culture of generosity will grow within the Body of Christ for the sake of the unreached (2 Corinthians 9:7–8).

## **Sunday, September 21**

Ask that Christians will be more intentional in their walk with God. Pray that amidst the noise, busyness, and countless distractions, we will prioritise our relationship with Him, staying rooted in His Word, and drawing strength daily from His presence.

## **Monday, September 22**

Pray for strength, unity, and grace in missionary marriages. Ask God to protect them from strain caused by pressure and heavy workloads, and to renew their love and commitment daily. Pray also for missionaries who are of



marriageable age that the Lord will fulfil their heart desires.

## Tuesday, September 23

The Africa Missions Association (AfMA) Conference begins today in Nairobi, Kenya. Pray for journey mercies for all participants travelling from across Africa. Pray that the Conference will catalyse fresh vision and partnerships for the advance of the Gospel across Africa and beyond.

## Wednesday, September 24

Jesus called the twelve to Himself first, *"that they might be with Him and that He might send them out to preach"* (Mark 3:14). Pray that missionary trainees will wholeheartedly submit to their training processes. Ask the Lord to mould them in character, competence, and conviction for fruitful ministry wherever they are sent.
