





The findings challenge us, comfort us, and, most importantly, direct our prayers and actions with divine precision. They reveal both the encouraging growth of the Church in certain regions and the sobering reality of the vast, unengaged people groups in others. This research is a gift to the Body of Christ in Nigeria, a tool for stewardship and a catalyst for unity.

We thus have a reminder that the task is not for a select few but for every believer, every local assembly, and every mission agency,

Wednesday, October 1

- Nigeria's Independence Day As Nigeria marks Independence Day, thank the Lord for the freedom to gather, worship, and proclaim the Gospel. Pray for righteous leadership, national stability, and a strong Church that boldly advances God's Kingdom in every sphere.

Thursday, October 2

Pray against wicked activities happening in Nigeria. Pray that the Lord will deliver the nation from oppression, famine, insurgency, crisis, poverty, and every form and shade of unrighteousness.

Friday, October 3

Ask God to raise men and women after His heart at every level of government in Nigeria. Pray that Christians in every sector of society will consciously carry God's heart for the nation, lead with integrity, justice, and a true heart of service.

Saturday, October 4

Pray for believers facing persecution in Northern Nigeria and other hostile regions. Ask God to protect them, strengthen their faith, and grant them courage to stand firm. Pray that their steadfast witness will draw many to Christ and advance the Gospel in difficult places.


Sunday, October 5

- World Teachers' Day

Thank God for Christian teachers, Seminary/ Bible school lecturers, and mission trainers. Pray for fresh anointing and strength for them to raise and impact the next generation of disciples and leaders. Declare the Lord's blessings upon teachers globally.

Monday, October 6

Count Down to 30, Vision 5015 Plus, Missions to Europe, and the Urban Missions Initiative are the NEMA four core emphasis this season. Thank the Lord for the progress made so far. Pray for greater understanding,





acceptance, and ownership of these initiatives by the Nigerian Church. Ask God to stir deep commitment in leaders and congregations for their full commitment.

Tuesday, October 7

Thank God for the successful gathering of the Africa Missions Conference (AMC) held in Machakos, Kenya, Sept 23–27, 2025. Pray that every resolution and commitment made will be faithfully implemented. Ask that Africa will rise boldly to take her rightful place in fulfilling the Great Commission, sending workers, resources, and prayers to the nations.

Wednesday, October 8

Pray for the advancement of Bible translation work. Ask God to provide resources, skilled translators, and supportive communities so that every tribe may hear God's Word in their language.

Pray for the education and discipleship of girls around the world. Ask God to protect them from exploitation and empower them to become godly leaders in their families and communities. Pray the Lord's blessing over every girl child.





Sunday, October 12

Thank God for the global Church. Pray for stronger unity among denominations, mission agencies, and networks, that together they may hasten the spread of the Gospel.

Monday, October 13

Pray for a gospel breakthrough among the 13 targeted unreached and least evangelised people groups in Nigeria under the *Countdown to 30 Initiative*. Ask the Lord to birth disciplemaking movements within these tribes, and bring about a lasting transformation.

Tuesday, October 14

Wednesday, October 15


Thursday, October 16

Since 1992, the UN has marked this day to focus on ending poverty and destitution. Pray for mission efforts tackling





poverty through vocational training, subventions, and discipleship. Ask God to break cycles of poverty, lift families into dignity, and raise thriving communities rooted in Christ.

Saturday, October 18

Pray for missionaries working in border and conflict zones. Ask God to protect them, give them boldness, and enable the Gospel to cross every barrier of fear and hostility.

Sunday, October 19

Creation reflects God's glory. Pray for wisdom in stewarding in creation care, both in rural and urban centres. Pray that Christians will be exemplary stewards of God's creation.

Monday, October 20

Pray for the upcoming graduation ceremony of the 2022–2025 sets at NEMI - that it will be a time of great joy, testimony, and commissioning for greater Kingdom service. Monday, November 10, 2025

Thursday, November 13, 2025



- NIMEC Day 2



Pray for the use of technology in missions. Ask God to inspire innovative tools and digital strategies that will help spread the Gospel faster, wider, and more effectively. Pray for wisdom and creativity for those developing and using these tools.

Tuesday, November 25, 2025

Global cities are melting pots of nations, cultures, and religions. Nigerian missionaries serving there have unique opportunities to reach diaspora unreached peoples. Pray for effective diaspora missions in the cities. Ask God to grant wisdom, boldness, and fruitfulness as they share Christ where the nations converge.

Wednesday, November 26, 2025

Pray for the effectiveness of discipleship movements in Nigeria and across Africa. Ask God to multiply faithful disciple-makers who will raise others to follow Christ in obedience, until communities are transformed and the Gospel spreads without hindrance.

Thursday, November 27, 2025

Pray for missionaries who serve as healthcare workers. Ask God to protect them as they serve the sick and to make their witness of Christ's love undeniable.

Global Activation (Activate): Pray for God's grace, wisdom, and power as Activate begins its





3-year Strategic Plan to connect God's people with His mission among unreached people groups. Ask the Lord to raise men and women of character, calling, and competence to serve as State Coordinators across Nigeria, igniting mobilisation movements in the Church. Pray also for sensitivity to the Spirit's leading in the rollout of *Gateway Project* 2, that it will effectively mobilise and equip believers to engage the nations.

Saturday, November 29, 2025

"But the word of God is not chained." — 2 Timothy 2:9. Pray that underground churches in North Africa will grow strong, and that missionaries will find creative ways to witness in restricted nations.

Sunday, November 30, 2025

Lift up new converts and other believers from Muslim, traditional, or secular backgrounds to the Lord. Pray for courage, discipleship, and community support as they grow in their faith despite opposition.

Monday, December 1, 2025

Thank God for the gift of a new month, and the last of its kind in 2025. Pray that December will be a season of hope, joy, and renewed commitment to God's mission.

Tuesday, December 2, 2025


From HarvestScope 3.0, Nigeria now has 37 unreached people groups and 3 least-evangelised people groups (40 in total). Thank the Lord for the progress made so far. Pray for these identified groups, that God will open doors for the Gospel, raise labourers, and ignite disciplemaking movements among them, until thriving churches are planted.

Wednesday, December 3, 2025

Pray for churches and ministries planning Christmas conventions this month. Ask God for anointed preaching, genuine revival, and lives transformed for eternity.

Thursday, December 4, 2025

According to **HarvestScope 3.0**, 21 of the languages spoken by Nigeria's unreached and least-evangelised people groups already have Bible translation





work in progress, while others have one form of translation completed. Pray for God's speed, accuracy, and provision for these projects so that every people group will soon have access to Scripture in their heart language.

Friday, December 5, 2025

God's Own Evangelistic
Discipleship Ministry: Pray for
the missionaries of this ministry,
asking the Lord to preserve
their lives, meet their needs, and
send helpers to support their
work. Pray also for the
upcoming Jesus Love @ Christmas
Outreach, that every provision
will be supplied and that the
Spirit's blessing will rest upon
this and all their evangelistic
efforts, bringing many to Christ.

Saturday, December 6, 2025

Over 80% of NEMA member agencies are already involved in urban missions, with many also planning to reach diaspora groups. Pray for God's anointing on churches and missionaries in Africa's growing cities to creatively engage professionals, students, and all categories of Urban dwellers, including migrants, with the

Gospel.

Sunday, December 7, 2025

Pray for missionaries serving in Muslim-majority areas during this festive season. Ask God to grant them wisdom and courage to witness with love.

Monday, December 8, 2025

Pray for Nigerian missionaries serving in Europe. Ask God to help them cross cultural barriers, shine as witnesses in secular societies, and bring revival to the continent.

Tuesday, December 9, 2025

Pray for mission agencies wrapping up their ministry year. Ask God for clarity, provision, and renewed strength as they evaluate and plan for 2026.

Wednesday, December 10, 2025

- Human Rights Day (UN)

Human rights in many parts of the world remain more theory than reality. Pray for believers suffering injustice and oppression. Ask God to defend the weak, uphold the persecuted, and let His justice roll down like waters.







Training is essential for completing the Great Commission. Pray for all NEMA member agency run mission institutions, seminaries, and Bible colleges. Ask God to raise Christlike trainers, provide needed resources, and equip missionaries for faithful and fruitful service.

Friday, December 12, 2025

Nigeria ranks among the hardest places in the world to be a Christian, with persecution rising sharply, especially in the North. Pray for believers facing these trials, that God will protect them, strengthen their faith, and use their witness to draw many to Christ.

Saturday, December 13, 2025

UMCA Jebba District Mission: Thank God for the leaders, fellowship groups, and mission support teams in Jebba District. Pray for the Dutse and Faranwa Ruwa outreaches, ask the Lord to strengthen new believers, deepen their faith, and cause them to bear lasting fruit. Pray for financial provision to build places of worship in these fields

and for courage and obedience in advancing the Gospel. Ask God to bless the District Mission Team with unity, effectiveness, and more labourers. Remember the missionaries and their families, praying for God's help, provision, and encouragement as they serve.

Sunday, December 14, 2025

Pray for local churches to seize festive period as a season of harvest, boldly sharing the message of Christ's birth with their communities.

HarvestScope 3.0 shows that 60.5% of mission organizations in Nigeria have missionaries working among Unreached People Groups (UPGs), 39.5% do not, while others only do occasional outreaches or provide support. Pray that every organisation will embrace consistent engagement with UPGs. Ask God to raise new labourers, strengthen partnerships, and provide resources until all peoples in Nigeria are reached.





Tuesday, December 16, 2025

Pray for mission efforts in refugee camps during this season. Ask God to provide food, clothing, and hope through the witness of His people.

Wednesday, December 17, 2025

Africa Vision Tract House Society (AVTHS): Thank God for 28 years of missionary work through AVTHS, including the distribution of over 28 million gospel tracts in 23 languages and evangelistic medical outreaches that have led to thousands receiving Christ. Pray for fresh resources, volunteers, and partners for their 2025/2026 ministry year, especially as they plan outreaches in Central African Republic and Nigeria. Ask God to empower every tract shared, bless their medical services with lasting impact, provide for the completion of their Legacy House, and grant protection and government favour in all their operations.

Thursday, December 18, 2025

Pray for Nigerian missionaries serving abroad who may be away from family this Christmas. Ask for divine encouragement, joy and fruitfulness in their ministry. *Global Impact Travail*, a monthly missions prayer meeting holds today by 4pm (WAT). Friday, December 19, 2025

Pray for missionaries engaging Muslims during this season. Ask God to grant them wisdom, courage, and supernatural encounters that lead to breakthroughs and disciplemaking movements.

Saturday, December 20, 2025

Pray for Christians preparing to give generously this Christmas. Ask God to open the windows of heaven upon them, and bless every sacrificial gift that supports missions and blesses the needy.

Sunday, December 21, 2025

Pray for rural churches hosting Christmas outreaches, often with very limited resources and capacity. Ask God to multiply their efforts, strengthen their





witness, and draw many to Himself through their outreaches.

Monday, December 22, 2025

As millions travel during the festive season, pray for safety on the roads, rails, water and airways. Ask God to prevent accidents, grant peace, and protect missionaries travelling to risky areas.

Tuesday, December 23, 2025

Evangelists to the Nations Missions (ETTNM): Pray for the team serving in Burkina Faso to remain strong, focused, and fruitful in their work. Ask God for divine provision to establish the ETTNM Base and Conference Centre in Imala, Ogun State. Lift their International Director, Evang. Olalekan Babatunde Amusan, praying for strength, grace, and wisdom to lead the ministry effectively.

Wednesday, December 24, 2025

As people prepare for Christmas celebrations, pray that hearts will be open to the true message of Christ's birth and the gift of salvation. Declare that activities will not hinder genuine encounter with Jesus, the reason for the season.

Thursday, December 25, 2025




